VIDEO

\$75 Van Transport
\$250 Camera equipment
\$300 Camera operator, \$45/hour overtime after 8 hours \$75/hours editing (May take 6 hours including webfiles & DVDs done the following week)

SOUND?

\$30 Audio mixer
\$25 Wired mic (Podium or Table)
\$50 Wireless mic (Lav or Hand)
\$100 PA sound system
\$240 Audio technician
